



## 2009 Scholarship Program

The Farm Credit Services of East Central Oklahoma, ACA, Scholarship Program was created to provide financial assistance for children of existing customers. The Association will award \$250 scholarships to eligible applicants.

### Qualifications:

Eligible applicants must:

1. Be the child or step-child of an existing Farm Credit Services of East Central Oklahoma customer (customer must be personally liable on the loan)
2. Be a graduating high school senior as of May 2009.
3. Attend an accredited university, college, community college, junior college or technical school full-time (12 hours or equivalent) during the fall 2009.\*
4. Agree to allow information about their award to be used in publicity materials

\*Applicants may pursue any major or degree/certification program

### Application process:

3. Applications submitted electronically or by fax will not be accepted.
4. Applications will be reviewed by the Farm Credit Services of East Central Oklahoma Scholarship Committee in May and recipients will be announced by May 25, 2009.
5. Scholarships will be awarded providing eligibility is met and the application process is complete.

### Scholarship distribution:

1. Scholarship winners will receive a confirmation letter by May 25, 2009.
2. Applicants are responsible to provide the Association with proof of enrollment by Nov. 1, 2009.
3. Scholarship money will be sent directly to the bursar office of the recipient's school when proof of enrollment is received.

***Children of Farm Credit Services of East Central Oklahoma employees or directors, or U.S. AgBank directors, are NOT eligible for this scholarship.***
